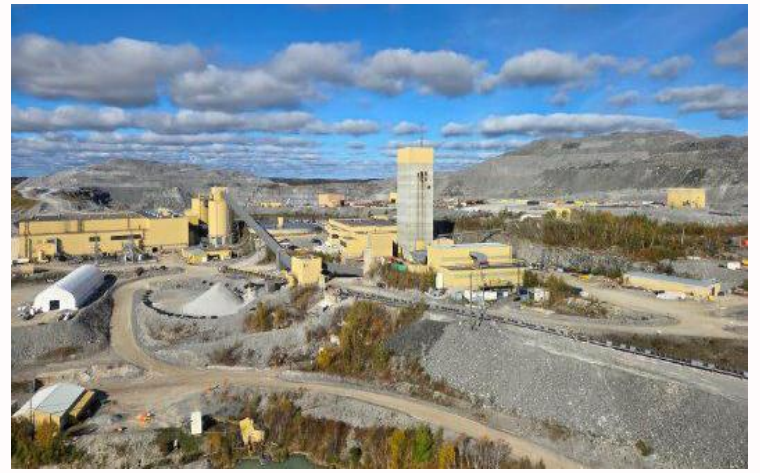


Senior Geologist, Exploration

- Greenfield or Brownfield exploration experience also considered.
- Advanced knowledge of geological principles and ore deposit models.
- Experience in Archean gold systems typical of the Canadian Shield would be considered an asset.
- Demonstrated proficiency with mining and database software. Experience with Leapfrog Geo or equivalent geological modeling software, Vulcan, Deswik, or equivalents would be considered an asset.
- Prioritization, organization, planning, scheduling and forecasting skills and experience.
- Strong presentation and verbal skills. Able to communicate ideas and recommendations in both written and verbal forms across all levels of the organization in a clear manner.
- Ability to lead and work effectively as part of a team, as well as independently.
